



Introducing: Boukili

A new reading experience!

About Boukili

Boukili is a program developed by Group Média TFO that provides an educational reading experience to children who are learners of French as a Second Language (FSL). This highly interactive program also contains mini games, quizzes, an adorable avatar, and travelling as the underlying theme throughout this learning journey! It contains a 54 book collection developed by Mini TFO. These books are divided into different reading levels*.

Once a book has been selected, students may choose to have the book read to them, read it or record themselves. I suggest that students do these in order. If your child chooses to record him or herself, I will be able to log in and listen to their recording which will allow me to provide feedback. I suggest that students work through each level before jumping ahead.

* Please note: these reading levels do not align with the GB+ reading levels that we use at school.

Once a book is selected:

-  This icon appears on the option to listen to the story being read. As the words are read they are also highlighted which allows the child to follow along easily.
-  This icon appears on the option to read the story. However, children may also select this icon  which provides assistance when needed.
-  This icon appears on the option to record. Unfortunately, this is only available through the App and not the desktop version.
-  This icon can be selected to have the text read back to you.

After a book is read:

Students must answer the comprehension questions correctly in order to fully complete a book. There are then two options: *Consulte ton passeport* or *Retourner au livre*.

Each time your child completes an activity, they gain a “stamp” on their passport. The more stamps that they earn, the more countries they will travel to. If you click on the country, you will find different activities that can be explored and completed.

Select this option to return to the book.

Boukili in the classroom

Once we begin our literacy centers, students will be using this program/App as part of "read to self". I have created an avatar for every Grade 1 student in the class. Students will individually work through the books.



Boukili at home

I highly encourage the use of Boukili at home. This is a great opportunity for students to practise reading in French. I love that students can read the story, have it read or record themselves and that each story is accompanied by comprehension questions.



Boukili can be accessed online or through the application. The App is available for Android and iOS and is completely FREE!
